TEAM PLACEMENT POL

- Every team here at Central Private reserves the right to hold a try out. However, we do not cut athletes that want to come play for us. The try out is held to determine placement for the athletes between a freshman team, junior varsity team, and varsity team.
- Each student-athlete is required to meet all expectations set forth by the head coach for that respective team. Such as but not limited to practice attendance, game attendance, off season training, and punctuality.
- If an athlete fails to meet the standard set forth by the head coach, proper disciplinary action will be taken. Depending on frequency and seriousness of the infraction, dismissal from the team can occur.



VOLUNTEERING

- Parental involvement is essential for a smooth and successful season. • Each home game requires multiple volunteers to keep things running efficiently. This includes working the gate, helping in concessions, assisting with clean-up, and providing pre-game or post-game meals.
- Every sport has different needs, and the head coach will outline expectations at the parent meeting before the season begins.
- Each family's involvement is a required part of supporting our student-athletes and ensuring a successful season.



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Start by meeting with the Coach. (You must speak with the Head Coach first before going to anyone else.)

If the issue isn't resolved, meet with the Coach and the Athletic Director together. (The Head Coach will always be part of the meeting.)

If the concern still isn't resolved, meet with the Executive Director. (This meeting will include the parent, Head Coach, Athletic Director, and Executive Director.)






TeamSnap- Used to inform athletes and parents. Not meant for discussions/concerns. Privately message/email the coach.

-Self Sustaining, pay for items as needed


