# SENIOR SPRING EXAMS 2026

Exemptions: Students in grades 6th-12th who have maintained an "A" average, per semester, in a class, and have no at-home suspensions for the year, may be exempt from their final exams only (midterm exams must be taken by all students for all full-year classes). Exemptions will be determined by teachers and approved by the administration.

# HIGH SCHOOL & MIDDLE SCHOOL 2026 SPRING EXAM ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

## STUDENTS THAT ARE NOT CLEAR WITH THE FINANCE OFFICE & LIBRARY

- Are allowed to take their exams
- Will be locked out of RenWeb and will not have access to gradebooks for their courses until the balance is paid

## NOTES

- If a student does not have a scheduled exam, he or she is not required to attend that class
  - If a student does not have an exam but must come all morning, he or she must bring work to study and will sit in their appropriate class for that time period
- Students will remain in class the **entire period**, even if they finish the exam early
- When a student finishes his/her exam period(s) for the day, he or she must leave campus or report to their teacher for the appropriate class period
- Line item snacks (not hot items) will be available during break in the cafeteria on exam days

## EXEMPTIONS (6-12)

The Student/Parent handbook states the following:

*“Students in grades 6th-12th who have maintained an “A” average, per semester, in a class, and have no at-home suspensions for the year, may be exempt from their final exams only (midterm exams must be taken by all students for all full-year classes). Class Exemption Policies will be determined by teachers and approved by the Administration and/or his/her designee, and communicated to parents and students at the beginning of the year.”*
